JESUS STARTS BY TELLING US SOMETHING SIMPLE

Jesus was an amazing teacher! He had a way of teaching very important and difficult things in a way that almost anyone can understand. Here, Jesus starts by talking about sick people, healthy people and doctors. All of us have been sick at some time.

HEALTHY PEOPLE DON'T NEED DOCTORS, SICK PEOPLE DO

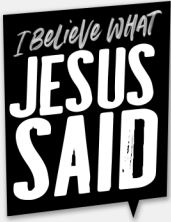
So if you know anything about the whole "doctor thing" you obviously know when you need to go to the doctor. You go when you are sick. You don't need to seek out the doctor when you are well. That is simple to understand.

NOW JESUS IS THE DOCTOR

After Jesus says what is obvious, He then begins to talk about Himself being a different kind of doctor. He talks about Himself not dealing with healthy and sick people, but with "the righteous and sinners." Instead of giving medicine or healthcare, what Jesus does is call people to repentance.

WHAT IS REPENTANCE?

You all may have heard the word repent or repentance before, but may not know what it means. The motion we have used for repentance is a "turning around" motion. One part of repentance is like a 180 degree turn, where you are walking one way and you turn around and walk the other. So in this way, Jesus is calling people to turn around from their life of sin and go a different way, His way. Secondly, repentance means to look at things differently, to rethink or to reanalyze. This year we are learning what Jesus said, to do just that. We want to see things differently. We want to rethink everything and see things the way Jesus does.

AND HE HAS NOT COME TO CALL THE RIGHTEOUS

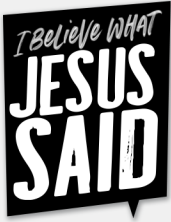
This is where things get tough. Jesus said He didn't come to call the righteous. This is a tough thing to understand because you want to think, why doesn't Jesus care about good people. Aren't Christians supposed to be righteous? But here is what we need to understand. Apart from Jesus, noone is righteous, noone is good. So "the righteous" that Jesus is talking about is people who think they don't need the doctor or people who "THINK" they don't need Jesus. These people are not righteous before God, they are self-righteous. How can someone who doesn't think they need to change repent? They are like someone who is really very sick, but thinks they are healthy and won't go to the doctor.

WHO ARE THE SINNERS?

Here is the other side of it too. Who are the sinners? They are people who know the truth that we all are sinners and we all need Jesus. They are the people who recognize their sickness and sinfulness and seek out Jesus not to just heal our bodies like a doctor, but to heal our souls like our Lord and Savior.

JESUS CAME TO CALL SINNERS TO REPENTANCE

Just someone who is sick seeks out a doctor. Those who recognize their sinfulness seek out someone who can save them. We call on Jesus because He never sinned and He died for our sin. He is the only One who can save us. He calls us sinners to rethink everything and change our lives.

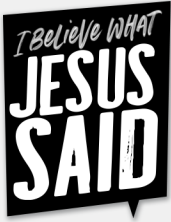

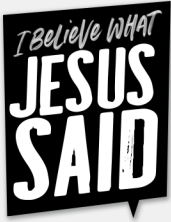
